Requirements

- ➤ Create an account on Elon's application portal
- > Submit official high school transcript or school records
- ➤ Submit TOEFL (80) or IELTS (6.5) or Duolingo English Test (110)
- Submit completed school report
- ➤ SAT or ACT scores are optional and not required*

*Elon's 4-year Nursing direct-entry program requires submission of SAT (min 1100) or ACT (min 22)
