

2014-2015 Priorities and Accomplishments

1. Communication (listening, assessing and sharing). We hosted ICC on the road in Irazu and the Oaks in order to ensure that ICC members are out in the community sharing the work we are doing across campus as well as listening to community members, assessing the campus climate and needs and using that information to inform our work.
2. Engagement. We updated our main landing website as a new way to brand diversity and inclusion work at Elon and engage members of our community in the diversity and inclusion work on campus including the many ways to gain knowledge, skills and behaviors that lead to more positive and meaningful interactions.
