

Best Questions to Ask Interviewers

Typically, an interviewer will ask “What questions do you have for me?” at the end of an interview. It is important to come with questions prepared to show your interest in the role. *Never say you don't have any questions.*

Sample Questions:

Roles and Responsibilities

- What are the biggest challenges people in this position face?
- What types of skills and experiences are you looking for in an ideal candidate?
- What does success look like in this role?
- What would a typical day look like in this position?
- Can you share an example of a project I would be working on?

Company Culture

- What is the company and team culture?
- How is diversity, equity, and inclusion practiced at this company?
- What is the best part of working for this company?
- What is the most challenging aspect of working for this company?
- What type of personality do you believe is best suited for this position?
- What interested you in working for this company?

Mission and Values

- How would you describe this company's values?
- What are the company's plans for growth and development?
- How do you see this role fitting into the company's strategic vision?

Other

- What are the next steps in the hiring process? When can I expect to hear from you?
- Is there any other information I can provide you with that would be helpful?
