PARTNERING WITH ELON

Elon University is seeking partnerships with Charlottebased companies, nonprofits, and community organizations to provide impactful internship opportunities for our students during the upcoming summer term. Join us in shaping the next generation of leaders by hosting talented Elon students in your organization!

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the fall of 2023, Elon University launched its Charlotte undergraduate program, offering students the unique opportunity to live and study in Charlotte with courses taught by Elon faculty & industry professionals. The program allows students to gain professional experience while completing Elon courses. In addition, housing and a variety of enrichment events provided as part of the experience.

START/END DATE

The summer program will take place from **May 27th to August 2nd**, with internships scheduled to run approximately from June 2nd to July 31st (9 weeks).

CLASS TIMES

All students will enroll in one Advanced Studies course during the summer program, with class scheduled for Friday mornings and site-visits scheduled for Friday afternoons. Students are expected to be available for internships four days a week, **Monday-Thursday.**

INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Students interested in the Charlotte program come from a variety of majors, and are required to complete **160 internship hours** to meet the program requirements. Internships can be paid or unpaid, but all students must receive **academic credit**. Students are required to work fully **in-person** or with a **hybrid** schedule. Remote internships will NOT be approved.

EMPLOYER EXPECTATIONS

For students coming from our Love School of Business and School of Communications: All supervisors are contacted three (3) times throughout the summer: at the beginning, in the middle, and at the end. This outreach provides us an opportunity to hear how the student is performing. You will receive an **intern performance evaluation** at the end of the summer to evaluate the student's performance.

For students coming from our College of Arts & Sciences: All supervisors will be contacted at the beginning of the summer.

For all students: Site supervisor must be a full time, professional staff member of the company with expertise in the work the intern is completing.

*As a supervisor, you may be contacted by someone in the career services office for an internship site visit when they travel to Charlotte. A visit does not mean that anything is wrong but provides an opportunity to see our student's work and build a personalized relationship with your organization.

**Keep in mind: Elon students are also completing academic coursework throughout the summer that is based in professional development, reflective learning, and meaning-making.
