Committees have both staff and faculty representation and help with the shared governance of the School. Each department will have representation on most committees, with the exception of the staff committee, which is exclusive to staff. Department Chairs led in the appointment of faculty to serve on these committees. To promote continuity, committee assignments are generally for two-year periods. Task Forces are for a specific purpose and representation on task forces more narrowly focuses on faculty interest rather than department. Serving on school committees and task forces is vital to its work and ensures broad representation to advance school priorities.
