GUIDELINES, FLOOR RULES, AND EXPECTATIONS

- ♦ Abide by the Elon University Social and Honor Codes, including rules related to mask-wearing and group gatherings.
- Keep all exterior and room doors closed.
- * Be considerate of other residents who are trying to sleep or study by turning down music, tvs, and talking quietly.
- Throw away trash when leaving a common area.
- Wash, dry and put away dishes immediately after using them.
- ❖ Leave kitchen items belonging to the Floor in the kitchen. Please keep your personal items in your room.
- ❖ Keep the Floor presentable in case of visits by faculty members, Residence Life staff, or future students.
- ♦ Inform our RA and Kristin and Ricky immediately of anything suspicious around the house.
- Create a community environment.
- Respect others.
