Ecofeminism is an ideology and movement that sees climate change, gender equality, and social injustice more broadly as intrinsically related issues, all tied to masculine dominance in society.



WHAT IS ECOFEMINISM?

Women worldwide typically hold less monetary wealth and rely on the natural environment more, they are more likely to be displaced by climate change and have to travel farther for resources, like water, as dry seasons extend

Both the oppression of marginalized groups and the oppression of nature are connected by cause.

2

We must replace our culture of domination with an ethic of care.

3

All forms of oppression are unacceptable and interconnected.
