In order to receive the most accurate estimate, please bring along the following documents/information: Federal tax information or tax returns, including W-2 information, for yourself and for your spouse if you are married; information on savings, investments, and business and farm assets; the current amount you have in cash, savings, and checking accounts (a recent bank statement will be helpful). Each family will complete their own Aid Estimator online (with the guidance of a member of Elon University's financial planning department) so information will be confidential.

Pi Scholars- Your families will be walking to the University library for a tour and library card as part of their programming.

If you are signed up for Spring SAT Prep this will take place following the Saturday program (lunch included) until 4/4:30 pm. Mr. Pickett will send a reminder email to the students involved.

CAT Mentoring:
