What is a **Resume?**

What is a Resume?

- A snapshot of your education and experience
- Brief and concise
- Easy to read, easy to comprehend quickly
- An easy way for an employer, admissions counselor, etc. to get a quick picture of your past experiences and potential interests



Resume Do's and Don'ts

Do's

- Use the page effectively
- Use action words to start each bullet point
- Have your education at the top, experience in the middle, skills at the bottom
- Include dates for all involvements
- Show not tell use your bullet points to show off your skills / the skills you gained from the position

Don't's

- Do not have typos
- Not longer than a page
- Do not use different fonts, be consistent with formatting
- Do not list "soft" skills –
 instead, show them through your experience
- Do not forget to proofread!
