
- The North Carolina Community College System:
- Unified two separate educational institutions junior colleges and industrial education centers.
- In1963, they were united as the North Carolina Community College System (NCCCS).



- The North Carolina Community College System:
- In 1995, the General Assembly mandated common course numbering among community colleges.
- In 1997, the first Comprehensive Articulation
   Agreement (CAA) was signed.
- An agreement signed that set the rules for transferring credit between the 58 community colleges, 16 UNC System schools, and signatory independent colleges and universities.

The North Carolina Community College System: In 2007, the first Independent Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (ICAA) was signed between the state's independent colleges and universities and the community college system.

In 2014, the CAA was updated.



#### University Transfer

- College transferable courses covered by the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA)
- CAA is a statewide agreement governing the transfer of credits between NC community colleges and NC public universities and has as its objective the smooth transfer of students.
- The CAA provides certain assurances to the transferring student; for example:
  - Assures admission to one of the 16 UNC institutions (Transfer Assured Admissions Policy)
  - Enables NC community college graduates of two-year Associate in Arts and Associate in Science degree programs who are admitted to constituent institutions of the university of NC to transfer with junior status.

#### **University Transfer**

Complete 60 credit hours

Credits are guaranteed to transfer to any of the 16 public universities in N.C.

Guaranteed admission into an NC public university Minimum GPA 2.0 CAA




#### NCCCS Student Transfers with Completed Associate Degree

#### Uniform Articulation Agreements (UAA)

- The Associate in Engineering (AE) and Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) degrees are governed by a program specific Uniform Articulation Agreement (UAA).
- Degrees under a UAA are only accepted at institutions that have the specific degree programs and these programs are competitive.
- Admissions to the Associate in Engineering (AE) and the Associate in Fine Arts (AFA) degree programs at four year institutions are not guaranteed.
