

### What to Bring to Elon Academy

(Please note we are checking on what size beds we will have this year and will let you know if twin or full size bedding is needed. We have plenty of full-size bedding to loan out, so no need to buy anything if you don't have it. More information to come!)

The following is a list of items that **will be provided** to you by the Elon Academy:

- Backpack
- Water Bottle
- Notebooks, paper, pencils, pens
- Identification Lanyard
- Calculator (as needed for course work)
- Athletic Equipment
- All other educational supplies needed to complete the program
- Sheets and blanket can be provided if you do not have any. Please let our office know by Friday, May 19<sup>th</sup> if you need linens provided by Elon Academy.

The following is a list of items that **you need to bring** to campus in addition to your normal clothing needs:

- One blanket or comforter (twin size)
- Pillow
- Towels/washcloths
- Extra-long twin bed sheets (see above)
- Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, shower gel, tissues and deodorant)
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- First Aid Kit (band aids, antibacterial cream, anti-itch cream, alcohol wipes, pain reliever of choice)
- Small trash can
- Extension cord
- Hangers
- One sweatshirt or light jacket for classrooms, cool weather or nights
- Umbrella and/or rain jacket
- Shower shoes (flip-flops that you wear in the shower and/or swimming)
- Athletic shoes and socks
- Clothing (what you wear to school in accordance with the dress code)
- At least one pair of shorts (not too short) or pants for field trips
- Any medication that you take daily or on a regular basis (this needs to be disclosed to EA staff before move-in day on medical information form)
- Bathing suit (be modest)
- Alarm clock & wrist watch

The following is a list of non-essential items that you **may choose to bring**:

- Hair dryer and or curling iron
- Hand soap
- Bath mats, floor mat, or carpet
- Snacks or eating utensils (microfridges will be given to scholars with medical needs)
- Radio/CD player /iPod that does not connect to the Internet
- Small lamp or reading light
- Personal items such as your favorite pillow, stuffed animal, etc.
- Musical instruments
- A book to read during down time or travel to campus visits

Please leave the following items at home:

- **Cell Phone**
- **All electronic devices that have the capability to connect to the Internet**
- **Computer, Gaming Systems, Television, DVD's**
- **Matches or lighters**
- **Candles**
