Grant PCard Deadlines

All **January Grant PCard purchases** must be approved by the Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP) by **January 30, 2026**. Grant PCard holders must complete their portion in the Works system **by close of business on January 27, 2026**.

Charges that cannot be verified as Allowable, Allocable, and Reasonable (AAR) by the deadline will be moved to the cardholder's default account.

Did You Know?

Policies You Probably Didn't Know About... But Should!

Did you know that you can't charge a grant for Petty Cash? Even if it is a reimbursement under \$150, it still needs to go through the Grant Check Request process.

The Office of Sponsored Programs must make sure all purchases meet AAR (Allowability, Allocability, and Reasonableness) because of grant stewardship and that can only be done with documentations through the Grant Check Requests.
