

Public Transit in Alamance County



ALAMANCE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (ACTA)



What?

ACTA provides general public and special needs transportation to anyone in Alamance County. ACTA utilizes vans and buses which are ADA equipped, including wheelchair lifts, to assist persons with specialized needs.

Where?

Transports riders to and from their destination of choice.

When?

To request transportation service, call ACTA office at 336-222-0565 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday.

One-way Trip: \$3.00

Round-Trip: \$6.00

How Much?

Sweeper Trips: \$6 one-way/\$12 round-trip Sweeper trips are for riders needing a pick-up outside of their designated time slot, within the zone schedule.

ELON BIO BUS

What?

The Elon University BioBus system provides free transportation to anyone. There are 6 routes, each with live NextBus tracking.



Where?

The University Drive Line provides access to shopping centers and restaurants at University Commons and Alamance Crossing. The Downtown/East Burlington Loop provides access to volunteer locations, shopping, and downtown Burlington, including the LINK Transit Transfer Hub.

When?

No appointment is needed to ride the bus. University Drive Line: Wed & Thurs 4-10 pm; Fri 4 pm-12 am; Sat 12 pm-12 am; Sun 12-10 pm.

Downtown/East Burlington Loop: Mon-Fri 2:30-6:30 pm.

How Much?

LINK TRANSIT



What?

Link Transit is your local transportation partner, serving Burlington, Gibsonville and Alamance Community College. The agency operates Light Transit Vehicles (LTVs), which are ADA accessible. The vehicles can also hold up to two bicycles.

Where?

LINK has 5 routes that each begin and end at the Downtown Burlington Transfer Hub. Those unable to navigate the fixed route system may qualify for the Paratransit System door-to-door service. Call (336) 417-5338 to schedule a Paratransit trip 48 hours in advance. LINK can connect riders to PART NC Express at Alamance Regional Medical Center.

When?

No appointment is needed to ride the bus except if you are needing Paratransit. Link Transit buses run Monday through Friday from 5:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Track buses by visiting: linktransit.transloc.com.

Regular Fares: \$1.00 per Ride, \$4.00 Day Pass.

How Much?

Reduced Fares with ID for: Senior Citizens (60+), Students, Disabled, Medicare Card Holders. Children (Shorter than the fare box) are FREE, and transfers are FREE.

Paratransit Fare: \$2.00 per ride.

GO TRIANGLE

What?

GoTriangle operates regional bus and shuttle service, paratransit services, ridematching and vanpools; provides commuter resources and an emergency ride home program.



Where?

GoTriangle operates an Orange-Alamance Connector route, which provides service to Hillsborough and Efland and gives riders access to the many other routes. This route begins at the Cone Health Mebane MedCenter. Go Triangle can connect riders to PART NC Express at the Mebane MedCenter.

When?

No appointment is needed to ride the bus. The Orange-Alamance Connector runs Mon-Fri 10:30 am - 2:30 pm. Track buses by visiting: triangle.transloc.com.

Orange-Alamance Connector One-Way Fare: \$2.

How Much?

Regular One-Way Fare: \$2.25 for Regional Routes and \$3 for Express Routes.

GoTriangle offers a discounted fare for youth (age 6 to 18), seniors (age 65 or older), and customers with disabilities.

PART NC

What?

The Alamance Burlington PART Express connects Greensboro, Burlington, Graham, Mebane, and Chapel Hill.



Where?

This PART Express begins at the Coble Transportation Center in Greensboro and provides service to Alamance Regional Medical Center, Alamance Community College, Cone Health Mebane MedCenter, and UNC Chapel Hill Campus and UNC Hospital. PART NC can connect riders to LINK Transit at Alamance Regional Medical Center and Go Triangle at Cone Health Mebane MedCenter.

When?

No appointment is needed to ride the bus. This PART Express runs Mon-Fri 5:30 am - 7 pm. Track buses by visiting: part.transloc.com.

One-Way Fare: \$2.50.

All Day Pass: \$6.

How Much?

10-Day and 31-Day Passes and Regional Fare Cards are also available.
