**A BILL REGARDING THE CREATION OF A STUDENT ART EXHIBITION IN THE
MOSELEY CENTER**

WHEREAS: Elon University's Art program strives to understand art in its many contexts and share artistic passions among all students, and;

WHEREAS: Students from the Elon University Art Department produce pieces yearly that the University has the potential to purchase and put on display, and;

WHEREAS: Arts West, the main location of the University's purchased student art, is located on the exterior of Elon's campus, which restricts campus-wide exposure and accessibility to the respective works, and;

WHEREAS: The Elon University Student Government Association pursues ways to support all students across campus through funding and elevating student-led initiatives, and;

WHEREAS: The Student and Iconic Art Committee was created in SB 20-2.4 to "allow for more student expression on campus in line with Elon's aesthetic values; including, but not limited to: decorative structures, "living" art, indoor student art pieces for common university spaces, etc." and;

WHEREAS: The Elon University Student Government Association has the opportunity to allocate reserve fund savings towards areas of student interest and to benefit the community; therefore:

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF ELON
UNIVERSITY THAT:**

ARTICLE I: The Elon University Student Government Association shall authorize \$15,000 from its reserve fund to the creation of a student art exhibit in the Moseley Center. These funds may be used for the construction of the exhibit space and maintenance of student art.

ARTICLE II: The selection and purchase of student art will be the responsibility of the Student and Iconic Art Committee. One faculty member from the Art Department will be added to the Student and Iconic Art Committee.

ARTICLE III: The Student and Iconic Art Committee positions shall be filled by the Executive President within two weeks of the passing of this legislation. The member from the SGA Executive Board designated to sit on the Student and Iconic Art Committee shall be responsible for providing updates up to two times per semester to the Senate during their respective report.
