PERM

[approx. 18 - 24 months]

- Step 1: Formulate job duties and minimum requirements
- Step 2: Request prevailing wage determination (PWD) from the Department of Labor
- **Step 3: Conduct recruitment**
- **Step 4: Submit PERM application to DOL**



I-140

[approx. 1 month]

Step 5: File Employer's I-140 immigrant visa petition with USCIS within 180 days of PERM certification



1-485

[approx. 12 months]

- Step 6: File Employee's I-485 adjustment of status application with USCIS when priority date is current
- **Step 7: Attend biometrics appointment**
- Step 8: Prepare for and attend interview with USCIS unless waived
