ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Fall room and roommate assignments are now live!

To view your room assignment, roommates and suitemates, please log into your <u>Self-Service</u> page (www.elon.edu/myhousing) using your Elon email username and password. If you are assigned to a Living-Learning Community (LLC), you will receive further communication about the community and expectations. If you do not see a room assignment, or see "Temporary House" as your assignment, please complete your housing application on Self-Service and then reach out to us at <u>residencelife@elon.edu</u> to be assigned.

Please note all assignments are FINAL and no changes can be made until the room change period opens in September.

MOVE-IN DAY

New students are scheduled to move in on <u>Friday, August 22, 2025</u>. All <u>move-in times can</u> <u>be found in your Acorn Account</u>. This time indicates when you are scheduled to arrive at our centralized drive-through check-in at the Schar Center.

NOTE: New students are not able to request an earlier move-in date. Students who are part of an approved early arrival team/group will receive separate details about scheduled arrivals later on in July.

Given the amount of traffic expected on move-in day, it is imperative all students and families arrive at their scheduled move-in time. Be sure to print the dashboard sign that will include your housing assignment to place in your car's dash on move-in day. This will help our staff direct you to the correct location. This will be made available in your Acorn Account later this summer.

Friday, August 22 is the first of four days of Orientation before classes begin on Tuesday, August 26. Additional information about New Student Orientation (NSO) can be found here. It is important to note that all aspects of New Student Orientation are required for all new students.

A packing checklist can be found on the NSO website. Elon community members will be available to assist you in moving your belongings into your room. Before arriving to campus, please mark all your personal belongings with your name, residence hall, room number, and a contact phone number.

Streeme TV & HBO Max - With Streeme TV, Elon students living in on-campus residence halls have access to more than 60 channels of news, entertainment, and premium programming in residential common areas that have a TV. <u>Streeme TV is accessible</u> by launching the app on the Roku home screen.

Elon provides students living on campus access to the HBO Max streaming service beginning 30 days before moving in and expiring 2 weeks after moving out. For more information, please visit the Student Technology Guide.

Bed Linens – All rooms in residence halls have extra-long twin beds, **except single rooms** in **Global**, **East**, and **Colonnades**, which have full-sized beds. Please plan accordingly when buying your linens. Bed lofting supplies will be available on move-in day.

MicroFridge Rental – Through Elon University's partnership with Standards For Living, Elon students may rent a microwave-refrigerator-freezer all-in-one combination appliance unit and have it waiting in your room before you move onto campus. These uniquely-designed units are the only microwaves allowed in the residence halls (except in kitchenette spaces in the Danieley Center). Please be sure to check with your roommate to avoid double orders as only one unit is permitted per room. The order deadline is **August 16**. Immunization Compliance – Students must be in compliance with state immunization compliance prior to arriving to campus. State statute requires that Elon University disenroll any student not in compliance with state immunization requirements. Barnes & Noble at Elon University – It is recommended that you order your textbooks online before arriving to campus, so they'll be ready for in-store pickup. Mail Services – Campus mailboxes will be assigned by August 1 and items can be shipped after August 10. If you are sending packages and boxes for the opening of the semester, you can go to the Mail Services website for the proper addressing format.

Laundry Services – Laundry is available in every residential community and is free of charge in all areas, except for The Crest Apartments. <u>More information on laundry services</u> and locations can be found here.

Storage Scholars - Students may also explore the "Ship to School" option available through Storage Scholars. Storage Scholars and their "Ship to School" program are the only vendor approved to deliver students' belongings directly to their rooms ahead of arrival to campus. GradGuard Renter's Insurance – While Elon University cannot and does not cover students' lost, stolen or damaged property, we certainly recognize your need for ensuring the safety of your property. Elon University is a safe and caring environment, but, like your home, it still requires forethought about protecting personal belongings. We have a partnership with GradGuard to offer renter's insurance to students and we encourage you to also talk to your insurance agent.

Parking Information – Please <u>review all parking rules and maps</u>. First-year residential students can bring a car to campus and are required to use the eastern most parking lot in the Danieley Center or the 500-space parking lot adjacent to the Gerald L. Francis Center on East Haggard Avenue. When purchasing a parking permit, you will purchase an FY permit. Students will be able to <u>use Elon Express</u> to access these parking locations. During off hours for the Elon Express, students may use <u>E-Rides or Campus Security Escorts</u>.
