We're excited to welcome you to the Rising Junior/Senior Housing Selection Process for 2026-2027! Please take a moment to review all the information provided below about our upcoming selection processes.

**Room Selection Times:** You will see your randomly assigned selection times live now on [Phoenix Living](#). All times are between 9am-4pm during each new resident process. Students stay in the same order for each process. Three students are admitted into the process every one minute.

**There are 7 selection processes for Rising Juniors and Seniors (please [refer to the timeline for full details](#)).**

- For renewal days, you do not need a housing selection time. One of the current residents will login between 9am-4pm to renew the apartment and assign roommates into spaces.
- The day before each "new residents" process, we'll open a "view only" housing selection process so you can see what spaces remain for that next process and get used to using the software.
- If you know someone who has not yet applied, they can still apply for housing but will be given selection times after everyone else.
- As a reminder, all apartment spaces on campus can be chosen as a mixed gender group. [More information here](#).
- Rising sophomores can join apartment renewals/apartment selection processes with rising juniors, but they cannot roommate group with anyone trying to select Station at Mill Point or Park Place (Junior/Senior only housing).

#### **Apartment Renewals:**

- There are three apartment renewal processes for rising juniors/seniors: Station Renewals; Park Place Renewals; and Oaks/Crest/Danieley Apartment Renewals;

- If you are planning to return to your same apartment/room, you must fill the full space (every room/bed). On the applicable day, anytime between 9am and 4pm, the student currently in the apartment who is renewing the space for the group must log in to select the space and place roommates IN THE CORRECT ROOMS. This is not a time sensitive process; you just need to renew your apartment before 4pm on the applicable day.
- Roommates of apartment managers in apartments are not eligible to renew the apartment because these apartments are designated for next year's staff. ?
- Again, on the designated renewal day, a current resident must simply log onto Phoenix Living ([www.elon.edu/phoenixliving](http://www.elon.edu/phoenixliving)) between 9am-4pm, choose Housing Application 2026-2027 at the top of the screen/menu. Then choose the Room Selection page of the application.
- If you are not the student currently living in the apartment, but are roommate matched to be part of a renewal, you do not have to take any action on apartment renewal days. Only the current resident will have access to renew their space with their selected roommate group. All roommates, once the apartment has been renewed, will receive a confirmation email.
- Everyone in the group must have completed the Housing Application for 2026-2027 and [join the roommate group](#) prior to selecting the room.
- In order to return, you must fill the remaining spaces in the apartment: either with your current roommates or other eligible students. Please [review our floor plans](#) and [roommate group size information](#). Sophomores are not permitted to live at the Station at Mill Point or Park Place. There are no exceptions. Please note- this is determined by the number of semesters lived on campus.
- If current residents do not renew their apartment by 4pm on the applicable renewal day, your space will become available for other rising juniors and seniors to sign up for during subsequent processes.

### **New Residents Processes (Apartments and Residence Halls):**

- There are four New Resident Processes for rising Juniors/Seniors: Station New Residents; Park Place New Residents; Remaining Spaces (Oaks/Crest/Danieley Apartments and some residence hall singles); and Juniors/Seniors Remaining Spaces for Individuals.

- Before each process, we will email all students in the process to give an update on how many spaces will be available. How many spaces available in each process is dependent on how many students renew their apartments in the previous processes. When we send these emails, we will also make the exact spaces available as a "view only" format on Phoenix Living so you can get familiar with the selection platform and "shop" and make a plan for what spaces your group is looking for prior to your selection time.
- Your randomly assigned selection times for all new resident processes are on your Phoenix Living now (you have the same time for each of the new resident processes). Please double check this time as it does convert to your local time zone if you are outside of Elon University right now.
- You will use the BEST selection time in your group and that person will select for the group. Please be prepared to make your group's selection when it is your time (or later, but before 4pm). Please [review our floor plans](#) and [roommate group size information](#).
- Everyone in the group must have completed the Housing Application for 2026-2027 and [join the roommate group](#) prior to selecting the room.
- During each process, if your group is not able to secure a space, you can then make a plan to participate in one of our other upcoming processes. We will email those students who remain in the process when all spaces during a process have been taken (i.e. when all Station apartments have been selected).
- Juniors/Seniors Remaining Spaces for Individuals
  - On Wednesday, February 25, from 4-5 pm, there will be a seventh process for students who want to live on campus but can't fill an apartment/suite space with other roommates.
  - On February 25, students who have not yet selected a space will receive a second time slot for the 25th (between 4-5pm), during which they can sign on and look for individual spaces in available apartments or a handful of residence hall spaces.
  - For this process, students will not need to fully roommate match or fill the space. They will continue to stay in the same priority order as the other housing selection processes for Juniors/Seniors. However, if a student selects a space with

roommates or suitemates earlier that day, they will be removed from the Junior/Senior Remaining Spaces for Individuals process as they will have secured housing.

## Reminders

- Housing Accommodations – If you currently have a [housing accommodation](#), we encourage you to fully participate in rising Junior/Senior Housing Selection Process to find a space that fulfills your needs. However, if you're unable to get a space, you have received an email with a link to schedule a time with our Housing Operations team on Feb. 26/27 so we can work to place you, and one "pull-in student", if applicable. Please wait to sign up for a time until after selection processes are over (there will be plenty of times).
- LLC Applicants - If you applied for a LLC, those acceptances will come out February 12. If you are accepted to live in an LLC, your selection day will be on February 19.
