IMPORTANT

- All North Carolina State laws apply on campus
- Towing is enforced! Any person parking in an area other than the area indicated on their permit will be in violation and may be ticketed and/or towed at their expense
- Parking Rules and Regulations will be enforced year-round

Rules and Regulations

The letters on your parking permit indicate your assigned parking areas. Any vehicle parking in any other space is in violation of campus parking regulations.

Parking in restricted areas and no parking zones, without a proper permit, could result in a fine and/or tow. The University reserves the right to change motor vehicle policies when necessary. Finally, the University does not assume responsibility for any person's motor vehicle when it is parked on campus. Parking is a privilege which can be revoked for rule violations.

Vehicles may only be operated on paved streets and shall be parked appropriately in designated lots. Parking or driving on the grass or Tram Path is prohibited.

Registration

Any student who wishes to park a motor vehicle on property owned or leased by the University must purchase a parking permit.

Students should register online to obtain a parking permit for their motor vehicle during or prior to the opening of the school year. www.elon.edu/parking

Registration Fees

The parking permit fee for 2022/2023 is \$160

Exception: Student Global Neighborhood fee is \$50.00. (These students are required to move their vehicles on football game days and during select basketball game days.)

Permits purchased January 1 to May 1, are reduced to half price, except for Global Neighborhood

Fire Lanes – MAY OR MAY NOT BE MARKED

Vehicles parked along a curb or parked in the travel portion of the street or parking lot will be considered, “Parked in a Fire Lane” and may be ticketed and/or towed.

Street Parking

Faculty/Staff may park on East Lebanon Avenue (north of railroad tracks).

Parking on the streets in the Town of Elon is under the town’s jurisdiction. Anyone using such space should understand and obey the parking regulations of the Town of Elon.

Disabled Vehicles must be reported to Campus Safety & Police, 336-278-5555. ***Notes on vehicles are not acceptable***

Bicycles

All bicycles must be registered with the Campus Police (at no cost). If you have a bicycle or motorized bicycle, it can ONLY be parked in areas designated for bicycles (bicycle racks). Bicycles not registered or found in any area not designated for bicycles, including, but not limited to stairwells, railings, brick colonnades, and gazebos, will be confiscated.

Visitors on Campus

If you have a visitor on campus, you will need to get a complimentary visitor pass at the parking office and advise them of parking rules, including game day parking.

KB – Colonnades, Loy Center

LEV – Low Emission Vehicle

- For vehicles with LEV permits ONLY in the lots they are permitted for. LEV spaces in Faculty/Staff lots are only for Faculty/Staff with LEV permits

LS – Law School

FREE

Law School students

- Innovation Quad lot
- **Elon University School of Law Greensboro, N.C.** Faculty/Staff permit will be issued by The School of Law to the Bellmeade parking garage on Green St.
- Law School students may obtain a Law School (LS) permit and park at the university parking lot located at Church Street and Friendly Ave., Greensboro

MP – Station at Mill Point

FREE

- May only park on main campus after 6pm

OK – Oaks, Park Place

\$160

Oaks and Park Place residents

- **Must move vehicle on football and select basketball game days** to Danieley Center, Innovation Quad, South campus or Mill Point

GR – Graduate & High School \$30

Graduate and High School students

- Innovation Quad lot, and Oaks lot (non-faculty/staff visitors spots only)

- Oaks lot (non-faculty/staff/visitors spots only)
- Park Place lot (designated spots only)
- Overflow: behind Schar Center, Hunt B lot (southwest corner)

15/20 Minute Parking

- Spaces are for registered vehicles ONLY with a valid permit displayed

GAME DAY PARKING

ALL VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED FROM THESE LOTS ON GAME DAYS BY 8:00 A.M.

Permit Placement

Student- Parking permits must be **clearly visible and affixed** on the right front section of the vehicle’s front windshield.

Faculty/Staff Permits-Hang from rear-view mirror. Do not place on dash.

Motor Bikes and Motorcycles-Place the permit on the rear fender.

Handicap Parking

To legally park in a Handicap space, a vehicle must display one of the following: handicap license plate, disabled veteran license plate, placard issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles, or a stamped parking permit issued by the University.

Temporary Handicap permits require a doctor’s note or a notification from the Office of Disability Resources before the University will issue them.

PLEASE NOTE

- The University cannot always guarantee a convenient parking place. Parking is available in overflow locations as needed. Lack of convenient space is not a valid excuse for violation of the University’s parking policy.
- Faculty/Staff parking lots are CLOSED to students year-round. Student vehicles parked in the Faculty/Staff parking lots Monday-Friday, 7:30 am -6:00 pm may be towed.
- Note: No student parking in Inman Admissions lot Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 6pm and Saturday from 7:00am to 2pm.
- Students are not considered visitors and should not park in the visitor spaces.

VIOLATIONS, FINES, AND TOWING

Students with unpaid traffic tickets will not be permitted to participate in graduation exercises or obtain transcripts.

Tow-Away Protocol

Three or more parking violations during the academic year may result in a vehicle being towed.

Tow-Away Zones

Any vehicle parked in a tow-away zone may be towed immediately!

Tow-away zones include any traveled portion of a street and/or parking lot, fire lanes, handicap spaces, grass or sidewalk, maintenance spaces, tram path, visitor's lot, faculty/staff lots, 20-minute spaces, or any other area deemed a safety hazard.

All unpermitted vehicles are subject to be towed.

If a vehicle on campus is towed, the owner is responsible for paying the fine and tow fee prior to picking up the vehicle. If the tow truck has arrived on the scene to tow a vehicle, the owner must pay the fine and towing fee.

Towing Fee	\$75
Traffic Fine	\$50

The total fine/fee to release the vehicle is **\$125**. If towed from the Tram path, fire lane, or handicap space, the fine/fee is **\$175**.

Appeals Process

If you wish to appeal a parking fine, you must do so within seven (7) days of the date of the ticket. Appeal Forms should be filled out online: www.elon.edu/parking/tickets
