

Parking at Elon

Who may park on campus?

Any Elon University student or employee may have a motor vehicle on campus provided it is properly permitted and legally parked. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to be aware of and comply with parking rules and regulations. For the complete list, please visit: www.elon.edu/u/fa/police/transportation-parking

Registration

Any student who wishes to park a motor vehicle on property owned or leased by the University must purchase a parking permit.

All Permit Parking

Permitted Parking: There are numerous parking lots on campus. The type of permit you have determines where you may park. Besides the permit designated lots, all Elon University students (except first year residential students – FY permits), staff, and faculty with a valid permit may park in the following lots at any time unless restricted due to a special event:

- Arts West Lot
- Colonnades & Innovation Quad Lot
- Danieley Center Lots A N
- Ellington & South Campus Gym Area Lot
- Francis Center Lot
- Historic Neighborhood lot
- Hunt B Lot (behind Schar Center)
- Ingold Lot

Visitors: All visitors to campus must have a visitor parking permit, which is complementary and may be obtained through the Elon Campus Safety Parking Office. Visitors must also adhere to any lots restricted due to a special event.

Visitors with a valid permit may park in any lot, except the Inman Admissions lot. If going on an Admissions tour, please contact Admissions for parking directions.

Student Athletes: Any student athlete, with a valid parking permit, may park in the northern most part of Hunt A (the lot immediately to the north of the north entrance to the Schar Center), *ONLY when participating in team organized meetings or practices*. Violation of this rule may result in revocation of this parking privilege.



Rules and Regulations

The University does not assume responsibility for any person's motor vehicle when it is parked on campus.

Parking is a privilege which can be revoked for rule violations.


IMPORTANT

- All North Carolina State laws apply on campus
- Towing is enforced! Parking in restricted areas, no parking zones, or in an area other than the area indicated on your permit could result in you receiving a ticket and/or being towed at your expense
- Parking Rules and Regulations will be enforced year-round
- Vehicles may only be operated on paved streets and shall be parked appropriately in designated lots. Parking or driving on the grass or Tram Path is prohibited
- Parking on the streets in the Town of Elon is under the town's jurisdiction. Anyone using such a space should understand and obey the parking regulations of the Town of Elon
- Disabled Vehicles must be reported to Campus Safety & Police, 336-278-5555. *Notes on vehicles are not acceptable*
- All bicycles must be registered with the Campus Police (at no cost). If you have a bicycle or motorized bicycle, it can ONLY be parked in areas designated for bicycles (bicycle racks). Bicycles not registered or found in any area not designated for bicycles, will be confiscated.
- If you have a visitor on campus, you will need to get a complimentary visitor pass at the parking office and advise them of parking rules, including game day parking.



Fire Lanes – MAY OR MAY NOT BE MARKED

Vehicles parked along a curb or parked in the travel portion of the street or parking lot will be considered, "**Parked in a Fire Lane**" and may be ticketed and/or towed.



Restricted for Resident/ Faculty/Staff

Please do not park in RESERVED spaces, at any time ... not even *"just for 5 minutes"*.

Towing is enforced!



Restricted for LEV

Please do not park in LEV spaces, unless properly permitted.

Towing is enforced!

Students

Parking permits must be clearly visible and affixed to the right front section of the vehicle's front windshield.



Faculty/Staff Permits

Hang from rear-view mirror. Do not place on dash.

Motor Bikes and Motorcycles


Place the permit on the rear fender.




LEV - LOW EMISSION VEHICLES

LAW SCHOOL



Elon University School of Law Greensboro, N.C. Faculty/Staff permits will be issued for the Bellmeade parking garage on Green St.


Law School students may obtain a Law School (LS) permit, and park at the university parking lot located at Church Street and Friendly Ave., Greensboro






INN AT ELON

Parking is reserved for guests conducting business only.

Students/Faculty/Staff may not park in the Inn at Elon at any time unless they are a guest of the hotel or restaurant.

Vehicles may be ticketed and/or towed



Other Permit Parking



20 Minute Parking

Spaces are for registered vehicles ONLY with a valid permit displayed.

Handicap/Accessible Parking

To legally park in a handicap/accessible space on campus, a vehicle must display an Elon Parking Permit and one of the following:

- Handicap/accessible license plate
- Disabled veteran license plate
- Placard issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles

Students in need of a temporary handicap/accessible parking permit should contact the Office of Disability Resources (336-278-6568).

Employees in need of a temporary handicap/accessible parking permit should contact the Office of Human Resources (336-278-5560).



PLEASE NOTE

- The University cannot always guarantee a convenient parking place. Parking is available in overflow locations. Lack of convenient space is not a valid excuse for violation of the University's parking policy
- Faculty/Staff parking lots are CLOSED to students year-round. Student vehicles parked in the Faculty/Staff parking lots Monday-Friday, 6:00 am to 6:00 pm may be towed
- Note: No student, staff, or faculty parking in Inman Admissions Lot from 6:00 am to 6:00 pm any day of the week
- Students are not considered visitors and should not park in the visitor spaces

Parking Violations and Fines

Campus Safety and Police will forward unpaid ticket information to the Elon University Bursar's office on the 10th of each month for the previous month. Please note that all fees due on a student's account must be paid in full prior to participating in graduation exercises and obtaining transcripts.

Tow-Away Protocol

Five or more parking violations during the academic year may result in a vehicle being towed.

Tow-Away Zones

Any vehicle parked in a tow-away zone may be towed immediately!

Tow-away zones include any traveled portion of a street and/or parking lot, fire lanes, spaces restricted/reserved for live-in staff, handicap/accessible spaces, grass or sidewalk, maintenance spaces, tram path, visitor's lot, faculty/staff lots, 20-minute spaces, or any other area deemed a safety hazard.

All unpermitted vehicles are subject to be towed.

If a vehicle on campus is towed, the owner is responsible for paying the fine and tow fee, either online or applied to your tuition. If the tow truck has been dispatched but has not yet arrived on scene, the owner must still pay the towing fee.

Towing Fee \$100 Parking Fine – Depending on violation

The total fine/fee to release the vehicle is \$100 plus parking violation fine.

Appeals Process

If you wish to appeal a parking fine, you must do so within seven (7) days of the date of the ticket. Appeal Forms should be filled out online:
