What is the Elon Experiences Transcript?

The Elon Experiences Transcript, administered by the Office of the Vice President for Student Life, enables students to present a university-validated record of their participation in the five Elon Experiences. These include meaningful experiences, both inside and outside of the classroom. The Elon Experiences Transcript is available to students through OnTrack and serves as a catalyst to incorporate out-of-class experiences with academic, career and personal development goals.

How can the transcript be used?

Faculty and Staff

- Use the transcript to help students map their Elon Experiences throughout their college career.
- Use as a prompt during advising.
- Plan coursework.

First-year Students

- Describe the Elon Experiences and how the transcript will serve as a record of students' activities during their tenure at Elon.
- Help identify ways students can be meaningfully engaged outside of the classroom.



Sophomores and Juniors

- Review what students have done since arriving at Elon.
- Look for patterns that can lead to majors, internships and career paths.
- Encourage students to find ways to take part in new experiences.

Seniors

- Help students articulate the value of their experiences as they prepare for job and graduate school interviews.
- Students can also request official copies of their Elon Experiences Transcript to include with applications for jobs and graduate schools.

Service

The Kernodle Center for Civic Life connects students with service opportunities to engage in the community beyond Elon. Each year, students demonstrate Elon's strong commitment to service through their work in the local community and across the globe. In the 2019-2020 academic year, 43 academic courses were linked to service. Opportunities were limited during the spring semester compared to previous years since the university shifted to remote learning in response to COVID-19.

Internships

The Elon Student Professional Development Center connects students with internship opportunities. University data has found students who prepare for professional roles through these experiences are more likely to be hired upon graduation. In 2019-20, a total of 881 students completed validated internships in 33 states and 14 countries.


