Study Abroad and Study USA

Elon once again earned a [#1 ranking in study abroad](#) by the Institute of International Education's *Open Doors* report. Additionally, Elon has been recognized as the top program by the *U.S. News and World Report* and the *Princeton Review*.

While many global programs have been canceled amid the COVID-19 pandemic and many students have had to withdraw or defer to a future term, some Elon students were able to participate in study away programs this past year. [Take a look back at 2020 in international education at Elon.](#)

Additionally, the University is seeing a return to near pre-covid numbers in upcoming terms:

- May Term 2021*: 69 study abroad
- Summer 2021: Over 100 approved for study abroad or Study USA
- Fall 2021: Over 450 approved for study abroad or Study USA

*In lieu of Winter Term 2021 programs, Elon created a special, one-time [May Term](#) for faculty-led study abroad. It is anticipated that 69 students will study on four programs, traveling to France, Greece, Italy, Spain, and Tanzania.
