**Student Involvement** 



Each semester, <u>Student Involvement</u> hosts over 75 student-centered programs, including concerts, comedians, late night programs, movies and tailgates. Student Involvement staff also oversee and support all recognized student organizations, including the chapters and governing councils within Elon's fraternity and sorority community.

Some highlights of what students can expect include late night movies, super bingo, themed trivia nights, comedic and musical performances, and tailgating prior to home athletic events. - A rotating Thursday night series, which includes trivia, bingo and coffee house events

#### **Declaring a Major**

Did you know that after successful completion of <u>Elon 101: The First-Year Advising Seminar</u>, your returning student can officially declare their major(s) and minor(s)? Not only would this official declaration provide your student with a specific road map to follow toward graduation (degree audit), but they would also be assigned an advisor who is an expert in that academic discipline. Additionally, this faculty advisor will assist your student in identifying major-related internships, undergraduate research opportunities, course selections and other major-related resources.

As a rule, all Elon students begin their tenure undeclared. This intentional policy allows for major exploration and/or confirmation of field of study. While your student might have expressed interest in a certain major upon admission, they must make an official declaration after the completion of Elon 101. Please note: As per the academic catalog, official declaration must be made by the start of your student's junior year.

Want to encourage your returning student to officially declare a major? Suggest that they visit the Academic Advising website's <u>major declaration link</u> and fill out the online form. It's as simple as that! There's even a video tutorial with step-by-step instructions.

If your encouragement prompts your student to declare prior to Sept. 17, your student is guaranteed a faculty advisor with enough time to meet before Winter/Spring/Summer registration!
