Global Education Center Updates

Over 900 students, faculty and staff are studying away this Winter Term. To help students and families remain up to date on how the pandemic may be affecting study abroad, Study USA programs and other global programs, Elon has created a [Travel Status Updates webpage](#). The page also offers an archive of the regular updates and messages that the Isabella Cannon Global Education Center (GEC) has been sending to students on global programs and their families as of Monday, Dec. 27.

The GEC is working daily and in close contact with global partner organizations to monitor changing pandemic conditions and track travel advisories and

restrictions reported by the U.S. Department of State, the CDC and airlines. The top priority of the GEC is the health and safety of students, faculty and staff studying away, and that of host communities. Decisions about the status of each program begin with considerations to protect the well-being of our participants and communities.

Additionally, over 250 students are preparing for study abroad and Study USA programs this spring, and over 100 international students will return to campus.
