Virtual health care available to students through TimelyCare

Last year Elon conducted a pilot for virtual medical and mental health care through [TimelyCare](#) – a service for students that provides support from

anywhere in the United States, 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, 365 days per year. The student response to the service was **overwhelmingly positive** – both for the access it provided to mental health and medical care, but also for the quality of those services. More than 1,000 Elon students accessed services last year and the evaluations after the visits were extremely favorable.

This year we have expanded the partnership with TimelyCare.

New services available this year:

- ***Scheduled Counseling:*** scheduled options to speak to a licensed counselor – evening and weekend appointments available
- ***Health Coaching:*** access to a nutritional specialist to help with healthier lifestyle behaviors related to sleep issues, weight management and more
- ***Group Sessions:*** weekly guided meditation and yoga group sessions, plus specialized discussions throughout the year.
- ***Psychiatry:*** access to no-cost psychiatry services (available by referral only; contact Counseling Services at 336-278-7280 for more information)

The service will remain available **in addition to** the existing in-person services at [Counseling Services](#) and [Student Health Services](#), and will continue to be provided with **no user fees**.
