What's new in Housing Selection?

- More available campus housing for rising juniors/seniors than in previous years!
- Apartment lease renewals allowed in all campus apartments
- No housing reservation fee required; simple 3 step process
- Consistent housing selection time throughout every process
- Roommate/lease turnover search guidance for using *Today@Elon* Want Ads
- Three new LLCs: Living with Data, Mi Casa, and Health Sciences
- Option for Renter's Insurance from GradGuard offered in the application

Who Can Participate in Housing Selection?

Housing Selection is for enrolled undergraduate students. Groups must be formed with people who are current students. Students on an approved leave of absence can participate.

Not eligible to participate in housing selection: Students who are graduating, have withdrawn, students who will be re-admitted for the fall, new incoming students, and new incoming fall transfer students.

Students who are studying abroad in Fall 2025 should not participate in housing selection.

Housing Selection Steps

APPLY

Complete the housing application through Self Service www.elon.edu/myhousing by February 10. How to video is available https://www.elon.edu/u/residence-life/current-students/housing-selection/overview/

MATCH

Start thinking about who you want to live with.
Many spaces require a certain number of people in a group to apply.

Everyone in your group must complete the housing application to match as roommates in self-service.

SELECT

All students participating in housing selection will receive a housing selection priority time to select a space, depending on what process they wish to participate in. Log into Self-Service at that time and select a space.

A different day/time will apply to each part of the process, but students are kept in the same order within each process.

Housing Selection Overview

Know your classification - Rising Jr/Sr or Rising Soph! Housing selection processes are based on semesters lived on campus. (Except for transfer students which is based on credits.)

Elon University does not guarantee housing for rising Juniors and Seniors.


Elon University has a 2-year residency requirement. Rising Sophomores are guaranteed a space on campus.

Where will students live?


While we don't have neighborhoods that are purely one class year, students will generally be housed in the following manner:

- Rising Sophomores: Colonnades, Danieley, Global, Loy,
 Crest, and Oaks (limited number). Most rising Sophomores
 will live in Danieley Apartments and Danieley Flats.
- □ **Rising Juniors:** Station at Mill Point, Park Place, and Oaks
- □ **Rising Seniors:** Station at Mill Point, Park Place, and Oaks

Apartments vs. Residence Halls

Residence Halls	Apartments
Global (including Trollinger House), East, Historic, Colonnades (including EcoVillage) and Danieley Flats	Crest, Station at Mill Point, the Oaks, Park Place and Danieley Apartments
Double, single or triple prices are flat (or the same price) no matter which neighborhood that space is in.	Each apartment has their own price point and can be found on the Bursar's office website, www.elon.edu/u/fa/bursar/tuition-and-fees
Residence halls close during Thanksgiving, winter, spring break, and summer.	Apartment leases are June 1 or 15 until May 31 each year and do not close during that time.
There is no lease and residents are eligible for room changes without finding someone to replace them in that space.	Students sign a lease agreement that is binding for the academic year. No room changes are allowed.

Roommate Group Minimums

If you want to live in a specific building, you must make sure you have the correct number of people in your group to be eligible.

<u>For Residence Halls Only</u>: Please be aware that if you meet the group minimum but do not fill that space completely, you will be assigned with one or more other groups.

- Example: If you are in a group of four and select the Danieley Flats for your housing, then another group of four or possibly two groups of two or others will join your flat.
- We make every effort to place returning students with other returning students and incoming students with other incoming students.

<u>For Apartments and Colonnades Pods Only</u>: If applying for these spaces, you must have the exact number of people to match the number of spaces.

Roommate Group Minimums

1	Singles in Global, Colonnades, or Danieley flats (students can sign up alone and be paired with another student in a double in the Danieley flats only)
2	Doubles in Danieley flats, Oaks (2-person apt), Colonnades (2 single rooms), Colonnades (double room), Global (2 single rooms), Global (double room), EcoVillage
3	Danieley flats, Park Place(Jr/Sr only)
4	Danieley flats, Oaks (4 single rooms), Oaks (2 double rooms), Danieley O-P, Danieley A-F, Crest, Colonnades (4 single rooms), Station at Mill Point (JR/SR only)
5	Danieley flats
6	Danieley flats
7	Danieley flats
8	Danieley flats


Housing Accommodations

- **1. First-Time:** Register with Disabilities Resources, complete full packet
- 2. Continuing (want same accommodations as previously received): Complete general Housing Application and indicate "Continuing Housing Accommodation on file"
- 3. Changed (requesting changes to previously received accommodations): Complete full housing accommodations packet

Emotional Support Animals (ESAs)

- **1. First-Time:** Register with Disabilities Resources, complete full packet
- 2. Continuing (want same ESA as previously approved): Complete general Housing Application and indicate "Continuing ESA Accommodation on file," submit updated materials to Disabilities Resources
- 3. Changed (requesting change to previously approved ESA): Complete ESA Request to Change Form

Rising Juniors and Seniors - Reminders


To determine priority order for students selecting assignments, students are assigned a random housing selection time.

The person in the group with the earliest time should log on first and select a space for the entire group.

All Rising Juniors and Seniors must have completed the housing application BY THE FEB. 10 DEADLINE to participate

Housing is NOT guaranteed for rising Juniors and Seniors, but we have more to offer this year than previously!

Rising Junior and Senior Process



Housing Selection Times

- February 12: Rising Juniors and Seniors will receive housing selection time in Self-Service
- *It will be the same time for each process (times will not be reissued between processes)
- Communicate with your roommates to identify which person has the earliest time selection time.

Apartment Renewal

- A returner (someone currently living in the space)
 can pull other people into their space but they must fill the entire apartment.
 - Only rising juniors and seniors can live in Station at Mill Point and Park Place
- Students who do not renew will relinquish their right to their current space and will become available for other students to select
- Students should complete this process between 9am-4pm on this day

After the final rising Junior and Senior selection process, rising Juniors and Seniors will not be able to participate in future housing selection processes and live with rising Sophomores.
