




- The SPDC utilizes a developmental model. Our career advisors teach students how to best represent themselves as professionals and pursue their career goals
- The SPDC is an opt in service on campus. Many students learn about the SPDC through their Elon 1010 class, but they elect to engage with our office
- 33% of our appointments are resume appointments, which are often a first point of 1:1 contact, these appointments lead to further conversations
- The SPDC has three advising focused teams, who support students by school and area of career interest

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- Over 50% of the SPDC team is student facing and career advising focused. In the career services space, we are very well resourced
- Students and alumni receive career services for a lifetime. We have a career advisor dedicated to supporting alumni
- We host drop-in hours Monday Thursday | 9:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m. across the SPDC
- The Elon Job Network (EJN) is our dedicated job and internship board. We also utilize EJN for appointments and event information
- The SPDC offers Career Exploration and Education Classes (CAE)
- Assist students with on-campus student employment (FWS/PACE)





SCHOOL OF COMMUNICATIONS


- All Communications students have to complete a for-credit internship

COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

- Career Advisor focused on Arts and Humanities
- Career Advisor focused on Social and Behavioral Sciences
- Career Advisor focused on STEM
- Newsletters for each branch within the college
- Dedicated Pre-Health advisor
- Graduate School advisor, supports all students
- Internships are not required for most CAS majors
- STEM Meet and Greet





SCHOOL OF HEALTH SCIENCES

- Dedicated pre-health advisor focused on assisting students 1:1 and offering professional programming
- Host Nursing Career Day and an event focused on networking for PA students
- Provide professional development presentations in preparation for Nursing Career Day





SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

- Focused career advisor who works closely with the school and faculty
- Advisor meets with all senior seminar in the fall and the senior supervisor class in the spring to review professional expectations of industry
- Host an education panel, to inform and educate students on the field
- Teacher Fair is offered every spring





SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

- All business students must complete a for-credit internship to graduate
- Professional development is embedded in curriculum through Gateway to Business class reaching approximately 350 students/semester
- Professional development in the MSBA curriculum
- The Career Catalog biweekly email highlights opportunities in EJN
- Career Paths with outcome information on PC website
- Accounting Meet & Greet and Business Job & Internship
 Fair in fall and a Business Fellow trip (another in spring)
- Piloting: First Friday Career Labs



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ATHLETICS

- Career Advisor focused on working with student-athletes (400), many requiring local internships to accommodate sport season and training schedule
- Provide a yearly networking event for studentathletes
- Works very closely with Elon University
 Athletics (compliance, NIL, etc.)



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ALUMNI

- Career Advisor focused on working with alumni
- Works 1:1 with alumni and collectively with affinity groups
- Virtual and in-person professional development programming
- Elon Q&A Al powered networking tool
- Bridges to Los Angeles program
