- Maintain a working knowledge of all Campus Recreation & Wellness programs and services
- Foster strong partnerships with other members of the Sport Programs team, as well as colleagues throughout Campus Recreation & Wellness
- Deliver quality customer service to all patrons, program participants, and visitors
- Attend all Intramural Sports team meetings and trainings
- Other duties and projects as assigned
