
## The Study Cycle



Skim the chapter, headings, and boldface words, review summaries and chapter objectives, and come up with questions you'd like the lecture to answer

**GO TO CLASS!** Answer and ask questions and take meaningful notes.

As soon after class as possible, read notes, fill in gaps and note any questions.

**Repetition** is the key. Ask questions such as 'why', 'how', and 'what if'.

- •Focused Study Sessions: 3-5 short study sessions a day
- •Weekend Review Read notes and material from the week to make connections

Periodically perform reality checks

- •Am I using study methods that are effective?
- •Do I understand the material enough to teach it to others?
