Now in its 16th year, Elon Law Reaches Out is one of Elon Law's enduring traditions, introducing first-year students to the Greensboro community while providing an opportunity serve our neighbors in a variety of settings. This year we are partnering with Guilford County Schools to help prepare local schools for the return of their students.
