The textbooks listed below are required for the Fall trimester unless marked as “recommended.” Textbooks are available from a variety sources, including the Barnes & Noble bookstore at Elon University and popular websites. Students may purchase new or used books, or rent books. There are web sites available for comparing book prices, such as www.bookscouter.com.

Some Elon Law faculty members allow the use of electronic books (eBooks), while others do not. Some points to consider are:

- During class, it may be challenging to use a laptop to see the eBook and take notes at the same time.
- The software for some eBooks may be “clunky,” causing lag time and other issues.
- Some eBooks are not paginated in the same way as the paper version. Professors may assign readings with page numbers for the paper version and expect students to figure out the corresponding eBook pages.
